

New guidelines for Requesting Personal Protective Equipment:

Piney Woods Regional Advisory Council (RAC) has the following Strategic National Stockpile (SNS) Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) in limited quantities:

- Face Shield, Full Foam Top ELST
- Gloves (non-sterile, powder free (Small, Medium, Large, Xlarge)
- Gown (Surgical, Sterile) (Large, Xlarge, 2Xlarge)
- Impermeable coverall without integrated hood (Large, Xlarge, 2Xlarge) (Very limited quantities)
- N95 Mask, 3M Particulate Respirator/Surgical (One size-Regular)
- Mask, Standard Procedure, Yellow, Pleat style w/Ear Loops

Procedure to request any of the above SNS PPE

Even if you have submitted a previous State of Texas Asset Request (STAR) for any of the above items you need to complete and submit a new STAR with the RAC PPE Request Form attached. Submitting a new STAR with the RAC PPE Request Form attached will expedite the distribution of much needed PPE.

1. Download and complete the RAC PPE Request Form (attached)
 2. Save the RAC PPE Request Form in your computer.
 3. Open a new STAR at the following link: <https://eoconline.net/eoc7/>
 4. The generic username is : COVID19PPE2020G
 5. The generic password is: Freedom1
 6. For the purpose of requesting SNS PPE from the RAC you may request all items in one STAR. This is the only exception to the one item per STAR request policy.
 7. Complete the STAR and attach the completed RAC PPE Request form to the STAR under the Request Description tab.
 8. Submit completed STAR with the completed RAC PPE Request Form attached.
 9. If you are unable to submit a STAR please email a completed RAC PPE Request Form to Brandon@RAC-G.org
- If the RAC receive additional SNS items you will be notified.
 - If you need items that are not listed above, submit a separate STAR for those items (remember, one STAR per item).
 - If you have previously submitted STARS they are still in the system and you do not have to do anything with them, but please submit a new STAR with the RAC PPE Request Form attached for the PPE listed above.
 - The Texas Department of State Health Services guidance on PPE distribution has been attached for your review.
